Job Summary:

Daily Responsibilities:

- Use overhead crane to load and unload stone and quartz slabs onto worktables
- Use pneumatic polishing tools to shape and polish stone
- Accurately read and understand shop drawings and job specific paperwork
- Verify quality of finished countertops by inspecting, measuring, and comparing them to templates and/or shop drawings
- Use tape measure to accurately measure and mark work before cutting notches and radii
- Locate and fill chips and fissures with epoxy prior to polishing
- Review and confirm the proper edge profile as identified for each component
- Advise the Shop Foreman of any missing and/or defective items
- Communicate job progress when transitioning between shifts
- At the end of the day and at various times throughout the day, clean work areas to ensure cleanliness and safe working conditions are maintained
- Perform minor maintenance on tools and equipment to ensure safe and effective operation
- Follow all Company Policies & Procedures and adhere to all OSHA protocols
- Assist with various other duties as needed
